4. On a motion made by Commissioner Vera and seconded by Commissioner Perez that we approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of November. Commissioner Vera and Perez voting "Aye" and "Abstaining" Commissioner Guerra and Commissioner Garza. Motion carried with Judge Cantu voting "Aye".
5. On a motion made be Commissioner Guerra and seconded by Commissioner Garza that we approve the payment of bills. Motion carried with all members voting "Aye" and "Against" none.
6. No line item transfers/budget amendments.
7. On a motion made by Commissioner Perez and seconded by Commissioner Garza that we approve the department reports. Motion carried with all members voting "Aye" and "Against" none.
8. On a motion made by Commissioner Guerra and seconded by Commissioner Garza that we approve 75% to Capital Outlay for Concepcion Civic Center & 25% to remain in General fund of the unexpected revenue from Valley Telephone Cooperative, Inc. Special Capital Credit to be allocated under Capital outlay expense line item in the amount of \$93,643.05 which includes prior amount of

9. On a motion made by Commissioner Garza and Commissioner Guerra that we approve to transfer all excess ARPA funds that were previously allocated but not expended as follows:
 - a. Additional \$10,013.31 to Freer Civic Center for pavilion additions.
 - b. \$19,986.69 for any current or additional projects at Judge Cantu's discretion.
 - c. All remaining funds to operating expenses for repairs to the County jail.

Motion carried with all members voting "Aye" and "Against" none.

On a motion made by Commissioner Garza and seconded by Commissioner Vera that we approve local agreement between Duval County and Texas A&M Agrlife Extension Service for 24-25 Feral Hog Abatement Grant from October 1, 2024 through August 31, 2025 in the amount of \$14,000.00 (\$10,000.00 reimbursement and \$4,000.00 local) Motion carried with all members voting "Aye" and "Against" none.

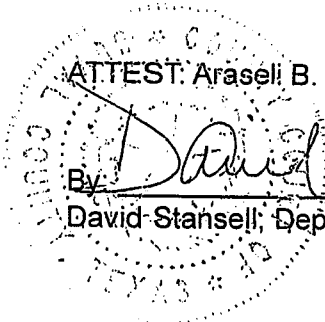
