Rates for each school child are shown separately. They are not included with any other compensation rates. All other entries on this chart reflecting a rate for children show the rate payable for children under 18 or helpless. To find the amount payable to a 70% disabled veteran with a spouse and four children, one of whom is over 18 and attending school, take the 70% rate for a veteran with a spouse and 3 children [$\$1,907.06$ (70% Veteran/Spouse/Child rate) + $\$70.00$ (x2 dependent children under 18) + $\$226.00$ for addl Schoolchild over age 18 = $\$2273.06$ total entitlement]. Dependency **IS NOT** automatic, Veterans must apply for their dependency status.

Where the veteran has a spouse who is determined to require A/A, add the figure shown as "additional for A/A spouse" to the amount shown for the proper dependency code. For example, in the above case if the veteran has A/A spouse (and all other dependency noted). Add \$130, additional for A/A spouse, to the rate for the 70% veteran for an additional \$130 increase, and \$2403.06 total entitlement.

* Individuals applying for BDD with less than 90 days prior to separation will be handled as an FDC, not as a BDD. To qualify as a BDD claim, applicants MUST have a minimum of 180-90 days remaining prior to ETS for submission, to allow VBA to schedule the required Compensation and Pension (C&P) examinations (no leave or TDY outside of examination area permitted - VBA will only allow "ONE" rescheduled examination). Missed examinations will result in an applicant being removed from the BDD program and placed in FDC.
